- 1) Vendors at the 2011 Tucson Rodeo have the sole responsibility for obtaining Business Privilege Licenses and for collecting and paying all City and State taxes according to City and State laws. The Tucson telephone number for City Business License is (520)791-4566. Pima County Health Department number is (520)740-2760.
- 2) It is agreed that the only items authorized for sale under this Agreement at the 2011 Tucson Rodeo are the following (please list all items):

- 3) **Due to exclusive licensing Agreements, we cannot allow the sale of cowboy hats, t-shirts, baseball type caps, jackets and sweatshirts. Also, no novelties or clothing with "ProRodeo" or similar logos. No PBR, PRCA, WNFR, WPRA, PWRA or National Sponsor 'logo' merchandise will be allowed for sale. Please call if you have any questions about these restrictions.**
- 4) All Vendors participating in the 2011 Tucson Rodeo will provide the Tucson Rodeo Committee with a *Certificate of Liability Insurance* document with a minimum coverage of \$500,000 combined single limit bodily injury and property damage, including product liability and fire. **The Certificate must name the Tucson Rodeo Committee, Inc., its Director, Officers, employees, volunteers, and the City of Tucson, Arizona as additional insureds.** Terms of coverage will begin with the date of space set-up and end with the date of departure. Failure to provide said Certificate will result in the loss of concession space.
- 5) The term of this Agreement shall begin upon its execution and terminate at 11:59 p.m. on March 1, 2011.
- 6) **Rental payment is to be made in cash, money order, MasterCard or VISA. Payment must be made when the Vendor Agreement is returned. There are no refunds.**
- 7) No amplification equipment of any kind, televisions, radio, or music of any kind will be allowed in the concession area.
- 8) Where provided, electricity may be used for lighting only; no portable heaters, coffee pots, hot plates or other electrical appliances will be allowed.
- 9) No weapons (or anything that could be considered as a weapon) will be allowed for sale in any of the vendor spaces during the 2011 Tucson Rodeo. Pocket or folding knives may be accepted.
- 10) No spray paint will be allowed in any of the vendor spaces on the Tucson Rodeo grounds.

- 11) Raffles conducted in vendor spaces must have a clearly visible sign indicating what is being raffled and the individual responsible for awards. Vendors must adhere to all state and local laws pertaining to raffles. Raffle tickets may only be sold within the confines of the space leased.
- 12) Vendors may **not** sublease the concession space. Subleasing is grounds for immediate termination of this Agreement.
- 13) No selling in the stands, bleachers or any area other than the designated space assigned will be permitted at any time. Leased space shall be kept neat, clean and free from debris at all times.
- 14) **The "Tucson Rodeo, La Fiesta de los Vaqueros" and the Tucson Rodeo logo are registered trademarks and cannot be used in any way.**
- 15) All gates will be locked at 7:00 p.m. daily and all vendors and their vehicles must be out by that time. The Tucson Rodeo Committee, Inc. and/or the City of Tucson, Arizona will not be responsible for the loss of any property for any reason.
- 16) Vendors are solely liable for the security of their merchandise, booth set-up, security and daily cleaning of leased space.
- 17) Vendors will be responsible for necessary staffing. The persons staffing concession spaces shall be employed by vendor and shall not be employees of the Tucson Rodeo Committee or the City of Tucson. Only personnel performing services for vendor shall be granted admission to Rodeo Grounds. Designated badges must be presented to gain admittance and must be working at all times while on the property. The Rodeo Committee will provide **two** vendor badges for each space rented.
- 18) A designated parking area will be provided for vendor vehicles. **There will be no electric, sanitary or water services available.** *Vehicles used for/loading/unloading goods must be outside of the perimeter fence no later than 10:30 AM each day.* There is no parking in unauthorized areas. Vendors must present authorized parking pass when entering the designated parking area gate. No vehicles may be left within the perimeter fence overnight. All vehicles operated on Rodeo Grounds property will be operated in a safe and prudent manner at all times. Speed limit on all Rodeo Grounds property is 10 miles per hour.
- 19) **Every concessionaire will receive two (2) parking passes and two (2) vendor passes. If you need more parking passes, they will cost \$10 each. For more vendor passes, they will also cost \$10 each. Please see Bud Krietemeyer for more passes.**
- 20) The signature of the vendor on this Vendor Agreement signifies that he/she understands and will comply with all terms of this Agreement and agrees to abide by all rules and regulations adopted by the Tucson Rodeo Committee, Inc.

- 21) The signature of the vendor on this Vendor Agreement signifies that he/she agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Tucson Rodeo Committee, Inc., its directors, volunteers, employees, sponsors and the City of Tucson, Arizona from all fines, suits, claims, demands or action of any kind and nature by reason of any and all vendor's operations hereunder, and does agree to and does assume all risks in the operations of his/her operation hereunder.
- 22) Failure to comply with the conditions of this Vendor Agreement will result in revocation of this Agreement, the forfeiture of the rental fee, immediate removal from the Tucson Rodeo Grounds and the loss of future participation with the Tucson Rodeo.
- 23) Vendors will be allowed on the Tucson Rodeo Grounds beginning Wednesday, February 16, 2011. Vendors will not be allowed to park or store equipment on the Rodeo Grounds prior to that date. Please see information sheet for additional information.

VENDOR INFORMATION SHEET

Vendors will not be allowed on the Tucson Rodeo grounds prior to Wednesday, February 16, 2011. Vendors must park in designated area.

No electric, sanitary or water services will be available in vendor parking area.

While there is security present on the Tucson Rodeo grounds, vendors are solely responsible for the security of their property - vehicles may not be left within the perimeter fence overnight.

Every concessionaire will receive two (2) parking passes and two (2) vendor passes. If you need more parking passes, they will cost \$10 each. For more vendor passes, they will also cost \$10 each. Please see Bud Krietemeyer for more passes.

RODEO GROUNDS CONCESSION ENTRY SCHEDULE

February 19 through February 27 entry and set-up between 7:00 - 10:30 a.m., except on Thursday, February 24, Parade Day.

The Tucson Rodeo Parade is on Thursday, February 24 at 9:00 a.m. and lasts until about noon. The route encircles the Rodeo grounds. Thursday, February 24 you must enter the Rodeo grounds between 6:00 - 7:00 a.m. in order to avoid the street closures.

Enter through Gate #23 on 3rd Avenue off Irvington Road. Vehicles must be removed from inside perimeter fence area no later than 10:30 a.m.

TICKET GATES OPEN AT 11:00 A.M.

THE RODEO BEGINS AT 1:00 P.M. AND LASTS UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 4:30 P.M.

PLEASE READ THE AGREEMENT CAREFULLY, RETURN IT TO THE TUCSON RODEO NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1, 2010 AND PLEASE RETAIN THIS SHEET FOR YOUR INFORMATION.
