

The following instructions will help you through the application process to Volunteer with the Tucson Rodeo Committee (TRC).

Please print your first and last name as it appears on your government issued ID.

If you wish to be called by a nickname, please fill this in.

Enter your current address, no PO Boxes please.

Enter you contact phone numbers please.

Enter the E-mail that you would prefer to be contacted by the TRC please.

Enter your date of birth, mandatory for anyone under 18.

Enter the name and phone number of a person who you would like us to contact in case of an emergency, mandatory for anyone under 18.

- 1. Please answer No or Yes. While we do not have a restriction to volunteer with our organization, a yes answer will prevent you from serving on the TRC committee per our By-Laws and Rules.
- 2. Briefly describe for us why you wish to volunteer with our organization. We are excited you want to be a part and want to hear why.
- 3. If you speak another language fluently (either as a native speaker or trained) please let us know what it is. We have visitors to our rodeo who do not speak English and we would love them to be a part of the experience with your help.
- 4. We are looking for individuals who have skillsets that help our organization grow and would like to utilize them, if you are willing. Please tell us about what you can do.
- 5. If you were referred to volunteer with the TRC, who did you speak with.
- 6. Tell us about your hobbies. They can be anything you like to do. Who knows, your hobby might be just what we need for a project within our organization.

The parent or guardian must also fill in the printed name of the parent or guardian on the line for "Under 18, Parent or Guardian, please print your name here"

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING) (rev 6/1/23)

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to officiate, observe, work for, use the arena, use the grounds, use the facilities, or participate in any way in any TUCSON RODEO COMMITTEE (TRC) rodeo, events or activities (EVENTS), I, for myself, my personal representatives, heirs and next of kin:

- 1. Hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, and DISCHARGE TRC, the promoters, participants, sanctioning organizations or any affiliate, subsidiary or subdivision thereof, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the EVENTS, premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or less control activities regarding the premises or EVENTS and for each of them, their directors, officers, agents, members, and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "RELEASEES," FROM ALL LIABILITY TO ME, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin FOR ANY AND ALL LOSS OR DAMAGE, AND ANY CLAIM OR DEMANDS THEREFORE ON ACCOUNT OF INJURY TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OR RESULTING IN THE DEATH OF THE UNDERSIGNED ARISING OUT OF, OR RELATED TO THE EVENTS, INCLUDING CLAIMS FOR WORKMANS COMPENSATION BENEFITS, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE. In addition, I COVENANT NOT TO SUE any of the RELEASEES based upon any claim arising out of any of the EVENTS.
- 2. Hereby acknowledge that I am not an employee of TRC, nor am I entitled in any way to workman's compensation benefits, and I ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE arising out of or related to the EVENTS whether caused by the NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES or otherwise.
- 3. Hereby AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to claims brought against the RELEASEES arising out of my injury, or death, or damage to my property while I am in the RESTRICTED OR PUBLIC AREAS and/or while competing, practicing, officiating, observing or working for or for any purpose participating in the EVENTS and whether caused by the negligence of the RELEASEES or otherwise.
- 4. Hereby acknowledge that RODEO EVENTS ARE POTENTIALLY VERY DANGEROUS and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I also expressly acknowledge that INJURIES MAY BE COMPOUNDED OR INCREASED BY NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS OR PROCEDURES OF THE RELEASEES.
- 5. Hereby agree that this Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the RELEASEES, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the State of Arizona and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, not withstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
- 6. COVID-19: With full knowledge of the risks involved of being exposed to and becoming infected with COVID-19 at the Rodeo held in Tucson, AZ, the Undersigned hereby releases, waives, and forever discharges the Organization and the City of Tucson, their respective boards and council officers, independent contractors, affiliates, employees, representatives, successors, and assigns from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, actions, and causes of action whatsoever, directly or indirectly arising out of or related to any LOSS, DAMAGE, INJURY, INCLUDING PARALYSIS OR DEATH, that may be sustained by the Undersigned related to COVID 19 while participating in the Rodeo held in Tucson, AZ.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT
I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR
GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO ME AND INTEND MY SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT
